

The questions school leaders ask most

What is Atlas K-12 in one sentence?

A connective MTSS and Care Team platform that pulls academics, attendance, behavior, and SEL signals out of the systems your district already uses and gives every teacher and counselor a single view of the whole child, with an on-premise AI assistant called Compass built in.

Who built it and why?

Atlas K-12 is built by AtlasOA LLC, a Missouri company founded by Ashley Reddick, an IT instructor at a technical college in the St. Louis area of Missouri. It exists because every district already has the data but nobody has a single place to see it and act on it together.

Is Atlas K-12 a replacement for our SIS?

No. Your SIS stays where it is. Atlas K-12 connects to it, reads the signals that matter for student support, and gives you a workspace on top of it.

Where does our data live?

On a server you own. Nothing about Atlas K-12 requires you to send student data to a third-party cloud. Compass AI runs locally on the same box as your data.

Does Compass AI call OpenAI, Anthropic, or Google?

No. Compass loads an open-source model directly onto your server. It never makes an API call to any third-party AI provider. It cannot send data out even if you wanted it to.

What SIS platforms do you support?

PowerSchool, Infinite Campus, Aeries, Synergy (SIS and TeacherVUE), eSchoolPlus, Ed-Fi, and OneRoster. If you use something else, ask and we will confirm.

How long does a typical install take?

Most districts are live in about two weeks: one week for server setup and SIS connection, one week for tuning and handoff. Written training materials are delivered with the install so staff can get up to speed at their own pace.

Is it FERPA compliant? COPPA compliant?

Yes. Atlas K-12 is designed to be FERPA- and COPPA-aligned out of the box. On-premise deployment makes most compliance questions simpler: your data never leaves your network.

Who uses Atlas K-12 day to day?

Teachers (dashboards and strategy library), counselors (Care Team workflow), MTSS coordinators (intervention plans and progress monitoring), administrators (building and district views), and specialists (SEL, reading, math, and behavior).

What is the Care Team workflow?

When Atlas K-12 identifies a student who needs support, it assembles a Care Team of the adults closest to that student, suggests research-based strategies, and keeps every adult on the team updated in real time as progress is tracked.

How is this different from Panorama or Kickboard?

Atlas K-12 is on-premise, owns the MTSS workflow end to end, includes Compass AI, and costs a fraction of what big cloud platforms charge. See the vs-panorama one-pager for a direct comparison.

What does it cost?

Founder partners get Year 1 completely free. Year 2 onward, pricing ranges from \$1,200 per year for a single school to \$12,000 per year for a large district, and you lock in your founder rate for life.
