

What is Atlas K-12 in 5 Minutes

Atlas K-12 is the platform your district installed so your MTSS team can see every student's academic, behavior, attendance, and social-emotional picture in one place. It runs on a server in your district - your data never leaves your building.

4 THINGS YOU CAN DO TODAY

Look up a student

Type a name, see the full profile: grades, attendance, behavior, any active intervention plans, last three care-team notes.

Ask Compass

Click the compass icon anywhere and ask in plain language. 'Tier 2 reading strategy for a 3rd grader who guesses words from pictures' gets you five options with evidence ratings.

Log a behavior incident

One form. Student, time, location, what happened, who responded. Posts to the student timeline and alerts their care team.

Print a Care Team summary

One page per student showing everything the care team needs before a meeting. Printable, FERPA-scoped, ready in two clicks.

Where to Start

DAY 1

- Log in with your district SSO (same credentials as your SIS).
- Open the home dashboard. Notice the flagged students list - those are the highest-priority kids to look at first.
- Click any flagged student. Read their profile top to bottom once so you know what the system shows you.

DAYS 2-3

- Pick two of your own students and use Compass to find a tier 2 strategy for each.
- Try the strategy library filter: domain = reading, tier = 2, effort = low. Pick one you like.
- Add one intervention plan for one real student. Use the workflow from the training documentation.

DAYS 4-5

- Attend one care team meeting with Atlas K-12 open. Run the meeting tool for that session.
- After the meeting, rate the meeting in Atlas. The rating is what gets the system better.
- Print a Care Team summary for your most complex student. Bring it to your next meeting.

Questions? Your district MTSS coordinator is your first stop. Everything in Atlas K-12 is reversible - nothing you click can delete a student record. Explore freely.

Atlas K-12 runs on a server in your district. No cloud. No student data ever leaves your building. That is why your district chose it.
